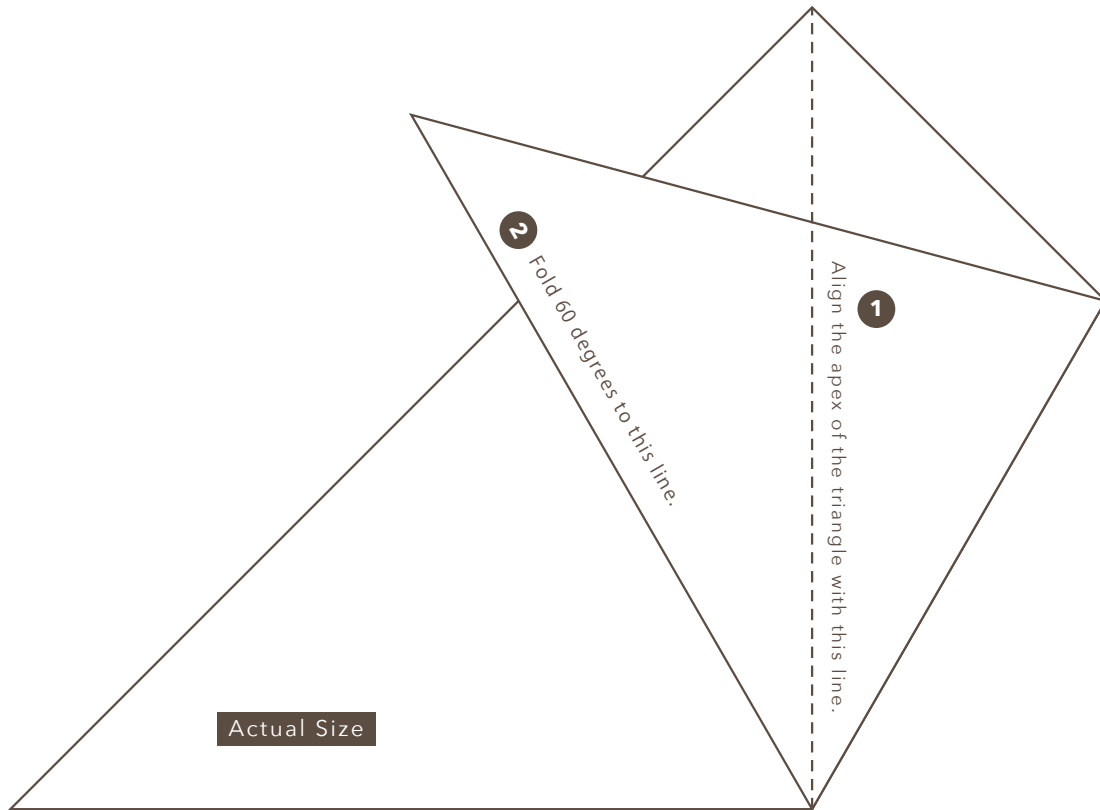


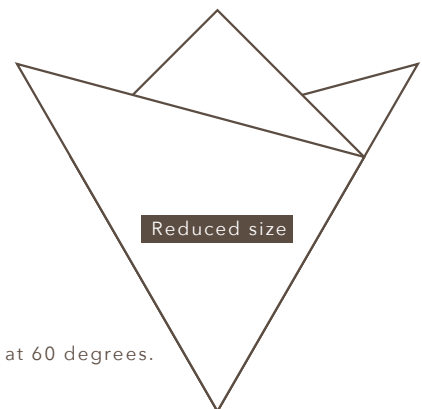
Monkiri Paper cut-out | Folding Guide

Here is a guide for the three-fold method.

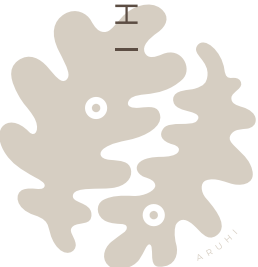
- 1 Place the triangular folded paper (15cm square) with the bottom of the guide and the center (dashed line) aligned.
- 2 Fold the right corner at 60 degrees to the guide.
- 3 Turn the paper over and fold the opposite corner the same way, 60 degrees.



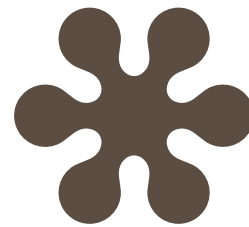
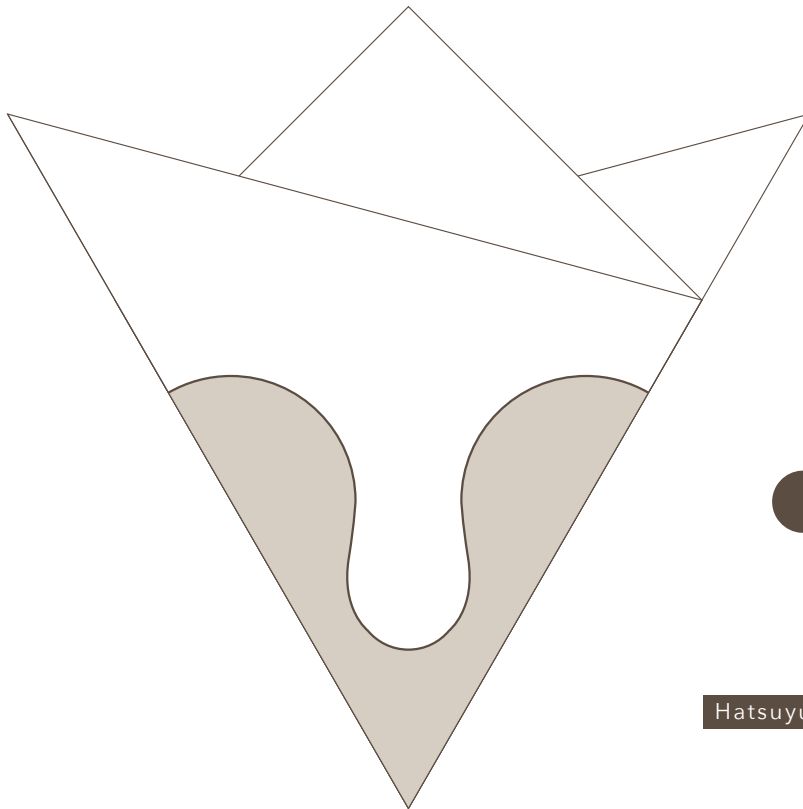
- 1 Align the base of the triangle with this line.



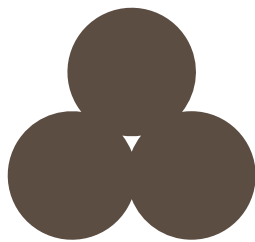
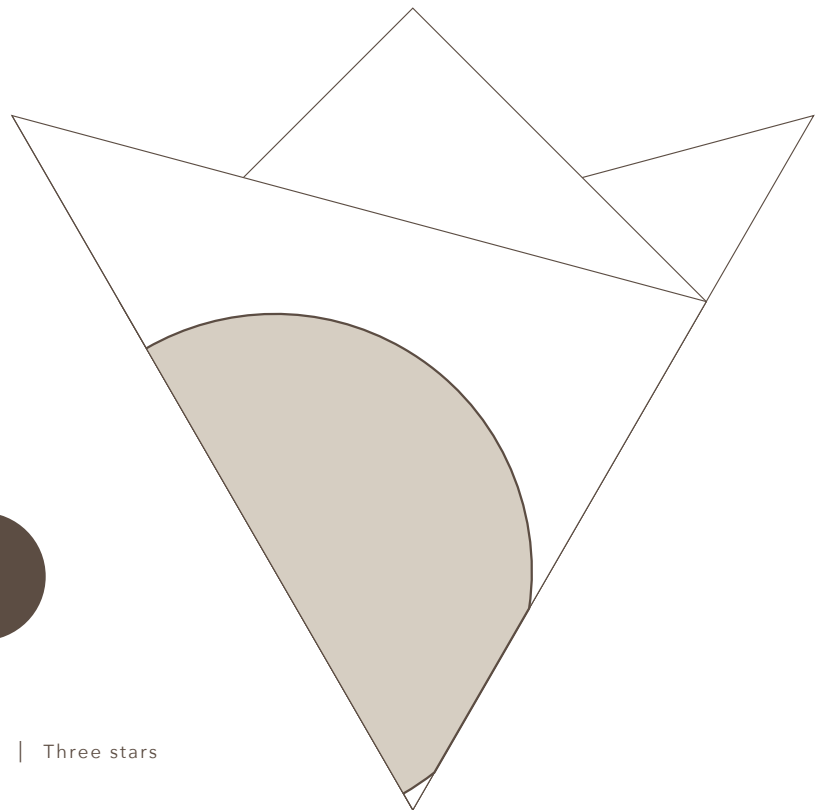
- 3 Fold the other side at 60 degrees.



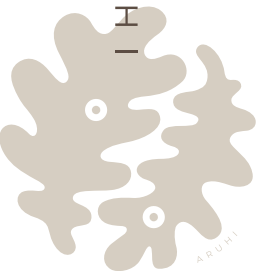

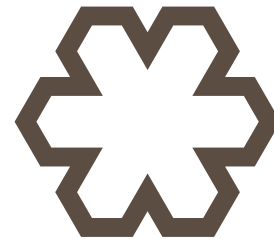
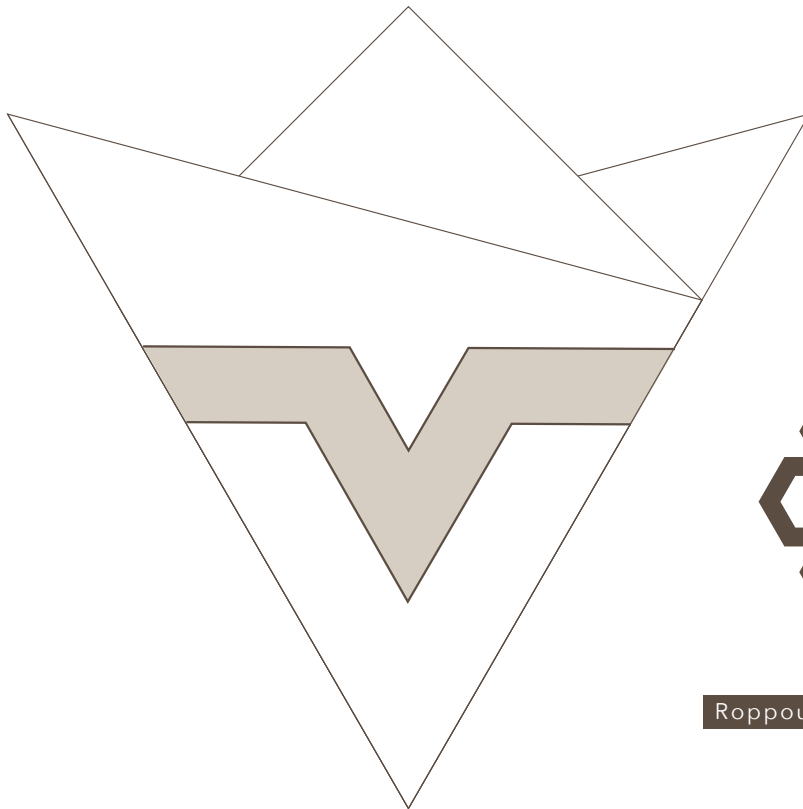
Hatsuyuki 初雪 | First snow



Mitsu-hoshi ミツ星 | Three stars



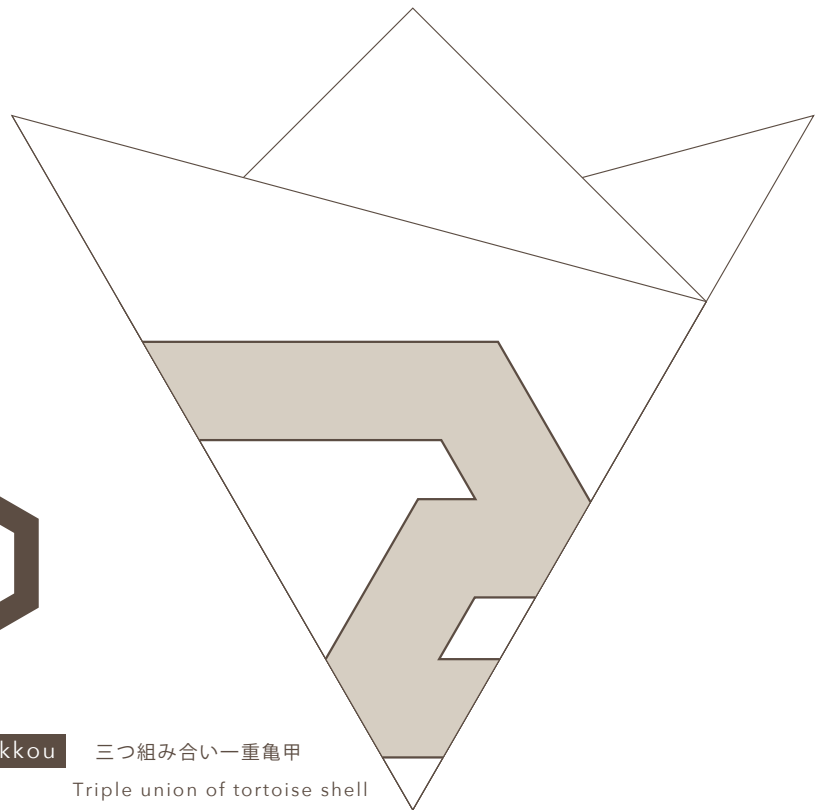

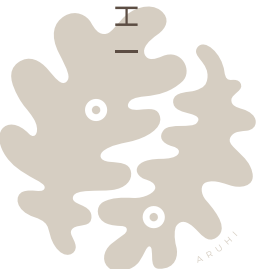
Hexagonal tortoise shell



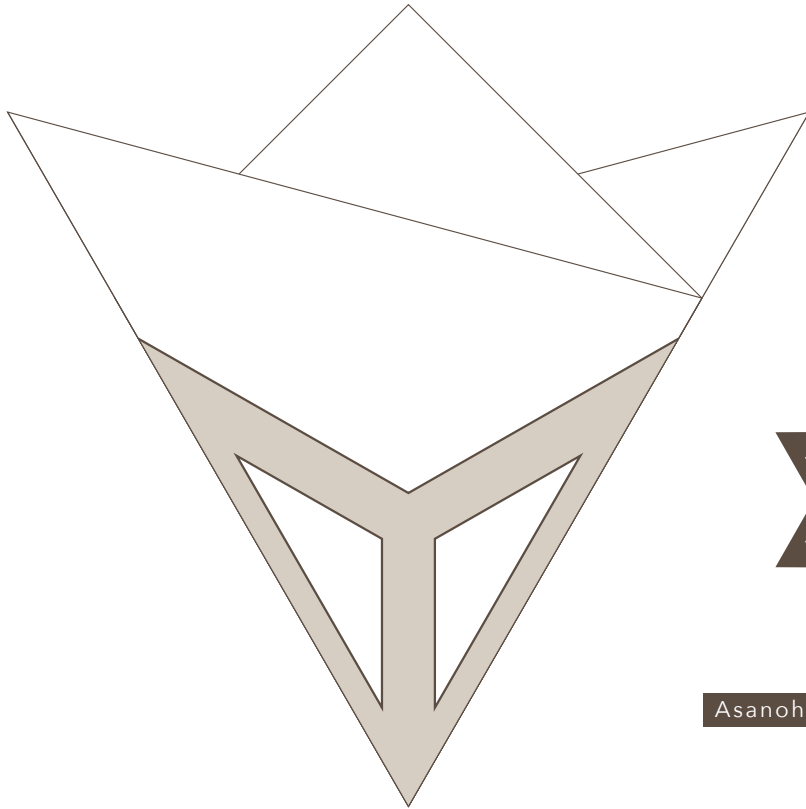

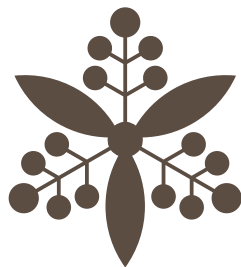
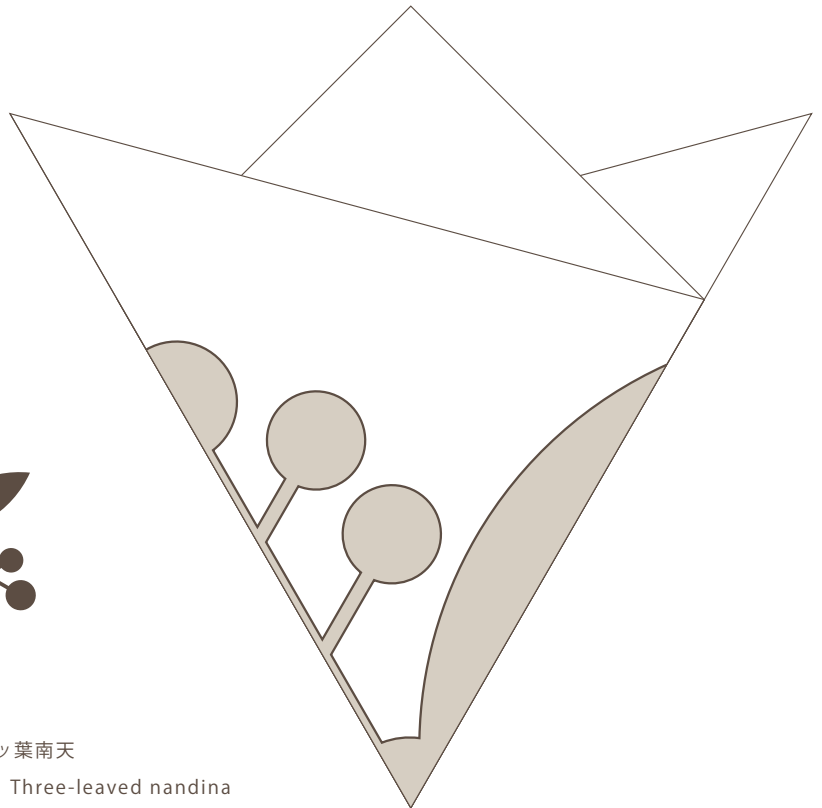
Triple union of tortoise shell
